The Holy Cross School, founded in 1931 by the Sisters of the Holy Cross, is a voluntary aided Roman Catholic School for girls aged 11-18. At Key Stage 5 the school has worked in curriculum partnership with our local boys school, Richard Challoner School, for the past thirty years, and post 16 lessons are co-ed. The school converted to academy status in August 2012. With 960 students currently on roll and over 100 staff employed, the school is proud to be acknowledged as being in the top 0.5% of all schools nationally for progress made from Year 7 to 11.

The Holy Cross School can offer you the opportunity to work in an outstanding school environment with well-behaved, motivated students who are keen to learn and where your professional development will be fully supported. In 2017 the school was awarded 'World Class Schools' accreditation, a quality mark given to secondary schools already judged outstanding by Ofsted who have moved beyond this judgement.
